Armenian Fairytales Musical Theatre

Registration: All students must register before taking class at AF Musical Theatre. Registration is complete upon the return of a signed Student Contract and payment of tuition and registration fee. Register early to avoid being closed out. New Students are encouraged to take a trial or placement class before finalizing registration. Class placement is determined by the artistic director and the decision is final. The AF Musical Theater does not offer instruction on a by-the-class or by-the week basis except to visitors from outside the area. Classes with less than the minimum number of 5 students are subject to cancellation.

Tuition Fees: The non-refundable registration fee is \$25.00 per student/family. This is an annual fee paid upon registration. The tuition for a full session is required and must be paid before the first class of each session. Payment may be made cash, check or credit card. There is a \$25 penalty fee for returned checks. All tuition fees paid or outstanding are non-refundable in the event of absence, withdrawal or dismissal of student from the school, unless written notification has been accepted. Armenian Fairy tales Musical Theater Inc. requires a 2 week notification for dropping a class. Without notification the student will be billed full tuition and/or no refund of tuition will be given. If a student withdraws from the class due to injury, they are eligible for a pro-rated refund. Gift certificates are available for any of our classes. Unlimited tuition is paid in monthly installments. Unlimited tuition is due on the 1st day of each month. A \$15 late fee is applied to unpaid balances on the 15th day following the first day of that period, and \$15 incrementally every 30 days thereafter if the tuition remains unpaid. No bills or statements are sent, but reminders are mailed on unpaid accounts. Extended non-payment of fees will result in termination of the student's participation and back tuition will be pursued. Students may pay the year's tuition upon registration if they wish. Early discounted registration may be applied. Enrollee understands that she/he is committing to an enrollment period and payment for that enrollment period.

Withdrawal/Changes: Withdrawals and other changes in registration must be submitted in writing to the Armenian Fairytales Musical Theater administrative staff. Phone messages are not sufficient, and instructors are not authorized to validate changes in enrollment or fees. Written notice of withdrawal from a class must be received by the office 2 weeks in advance of anticipated withdrawal. A credit/refund will be issued if cancellation occurs before the second class meeting. The registration fee is not refundable.

Attendance Policy: Regular attendance is highly recommended. Students should arrive to class on time. Students should attend each class for maximum benefit and progress. Absence due to illness must be reported by phone to the studio. Students must be currently registered and in good standing in order to take make up class. No refunds or credit will be given for missed classes. These make-up classes must be taken within the current session and must be at a level of equal or lower level. As a courtesy to our teachers, students and staff we ask that whenever possible please give advance notice of taking a make-up class. We will try to keep class size at a maximum with the exception of the occasional addition of students making up missed classes.

Injuries: Armenian Fairytales Musical Theater is not responsible for injuries sustained during class, rehearsals and performances. We do have First Aid Kits available in case, including ice packs if necessary. All students must sign a Release and Indemnification form with the start of each new session registration.

Class Placement: Placement for students is determined by department head teachers. Conferences with teachers and/or staff can be arranged at any time for those who have questions or concerns regarding classes and placement.

Armenian Fairytales Musical Theater does not discriminate in enrollment on the basis of race, religion, sex, national origin, or sexual orientation.

Additional Fees

There will be a fee before a show for all students to cover the expenses for all purchased props, decor, costumes, etc. This fee will be decided per concert by the directors and the fee will be \$280. This is mandatory due to Armenian Fairytale Musical Theatre rules and regulations.

If necessary for a performance, students must purchase dance attire such as color slippers, colored pantyhose, shorts or any other casual wear that will not be provided by the studio.

DRESS CODE: All students must arrive to class in proper and comfortable dance attire. The best bottoms would include leggings, or a skirt with tights. Jeans, jeggings, baggy sweats, short shorts, are NOT considered dance attire to rehearse in. Armenian Fairytale T-shirts are available for purchase in the Office, and are recommended. Other acceptable tops include plain T-shirts, plain long sleeves, and leotards. Dance shoes/ballet slippers are the ONLY acceptable shoes to be worn in the studio.

HAIR: Students must come to class with neat and tidy hair. Long hair should be in a bun and shorter hair can be clipped back. Hair should not be a distraction in dancing and acting class, and doing this helps prepare for the show. This applies to both male and female students.

MAKEUP & JEWELRY: Minimal makeup and jewelry are allowed, but if either become a distraction in class, they will be prohibited.

TIME MANAGEMENT: It is important to know when your classes are during the week, and what time they begin and end. Do not rely on your parents to remind you when you have rehearsal. Being on time is a great habit to maintain!

WHAT TO BRING: All students should walk in with a folder dedicated to their Armenian Fairytale class. They may be given printed hand-outs such as songs to learn, scripts to memorize, and schedules. They must bring this to every class!
